


#### Norway – innovation and entrepeneurship

- Population of Norway is 5 million people
- GDP 479,3 US \$ billions
- GDP per capita PPP\$ 53,376.2
- Global Innovation Index (141 participating countries) is on 14<sup>th</sup> place. It has score 56 (scale 0-100)
- Institutions (political, business, regulatory environment) 5<sup>th</sup> place
- Human capital and research (education and R&D)
  13<sup>th</sup> place
- Infrastructure (ICT, general, ecological) 2<sup>nd</sup> place



#### Global Innovation index continues

- Market sophistication (credit, investment, trade and competition)- 19th place
- Knowledge and technology outputs (knowledge creation, knowlegde impact, knowlegde diffusion)
  26th place
- Creative outputs (creative intangibles, creative goods and services, online creativity) 5th place






### Global Entrepeneurship Monitor

- Measure entrepeneurship activity
- 59 countries
- TEA –The early stage entrepreneurial activity (TEA) index includes percentages for people between 18–64 years of age, who are either a nascent entrepreneur or owner-manager of a new business

- Today it houses the innovation park almost 150 different companies with over 800 employees
- Part of expert environment in Ullandshaug, including UiS and IRIS
- Business Incubator
